UNCONSCIOUS BIAS – OUR SECRET BRAIN SHORTCUTS

Our brain is constantly being flooded with a stream of information. But we simply cannot process all of it consciously. So, in order not to overwhelm us and to make sense of the world more easily, our brain automatically sorts and categorises what it perceives. As a result, we tend to see the world the way we already know it and think along familiar lines. But there is a problem: this also happens when we meet other people. Our brain categorises them based on our unconscious biases. Without us realising it, this affects how we act — and can lead to discrimination, for example based on gender, age, religion, or skin color. Biases reflect and reinforce existing power balances in society.

WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT FROM THE WORKSHOP?

In this workshop, you and your colleagues will learn how to recognise unconscious biases and stereotypical expectations – and how to actively counter them. You'll gain hands-on insights into the role unconscious bias plays in equity and diversity management within organizations – and what you can do to spark real change. By the end of the workshop, you'll be able to identify bias more consciously and apply what you've learned within your workplace – to help create a more inclusive and equitable work environment.

HOW DOES THE WORKSHOP TAKE PLACE?

The workshop takes place in-person or online. In both our in-person and and virtual sessions, we encourage active participation and look forward to lively discussions. In our workshops, there are no "naive" questions - we open up a space that takes the needs of all participants into consideration. 
